Dear Judge Mennen:

This office represents Defendant Town of Phillipsburg in the above-captioned matter. With the consent of my adversary, I make this request for: (1) an additional one-cycle adjournment of the pending summary judgment motion in the Morrisette case, and (2) the adjournment of a case management conference scheduled for next week, June 5, 2024.

My adversary and I make these requests because the parties have discussed a negotiated resolution of the Morrisette case. To approve this proposed disposition, the Phillipsburg governing body must meet and hold an executive session, which it intends to do at its next opportunity on June 12, 2024.

As such, my adversary and I are respectfully requesting that the case management conference scheduled for June 5, 2024 under both the Morrisette and Kormandy dockets be adjourned until a date later in June. This will allow the Court to conference this matter after the Morrisette case is likely resolved and with only the Kormandy case remaining and requiring adjudication.

My adversary and I further request that the motion for summary judgment that is pending in the Morrisette case be adjourned one additional motion cycle from the current June 20, 2024 return date. That adjournment would allow the parties to resolve the Morrisette case without Defendant needing to file opposition prior to the aforementioned governing body meeting.
